- 6. **Abilities**: Interpersonal skills. Listening, speaking and writing skills, Intercultural competence & Proactive approach. Strong management capability and ability to prioritize and deal with multiple tasks.
- 7. Age: This position is ideal for a young person between 23 to 35 years.
