About Indian Higher Education Sector

New - Age Higher Education Landscape

- India is the largest higher education system in the world in terms of the number of institutions (840 plus Universities and 51000 colleges/institutions) and second-largest in terms of enrolment (34.5 million students)
- By 2030, India is expected to be a USD 7.5 trillion plus economy and with nearly 140 million people in the college going age-group, one in every four graduates in the world will be a product of the Indian higher education system.
- With a transition from Education 1.0 to Education 4.0 - the new 'normal' has shifted its focus from 'what is taught' to 'the way it is taught'
 - Increased usage of media tools and platforms for learning any time and any where
 - Interactive boards replacing chalkboards
 - Increased use of personal devices
