Qualifications and Requirements

1. Qualification

(a) Demonstrated excellence in the specific sport or activity for which the selection is being made. Candidates with a coaching diploma in the relevant game or sport will receive additional consideration.

(b) Should be able to communicate in English or, at a minimum, understand the language.

2. Experience

(a) Should have competed at the National / Continental level such as Asian / European / World Championship or Asian / Olympic Games.

(b) Should possess experience training their country's Junior National Team or Senior National Team for a period of approximately 3-5 years.

(c) Should possess a proven record of coaching athletes to medal-winning performances at Asian, European, World Championship, or Olympic competitions.

(d) Should possess physical fitness necessary to demonstrate the techniques effectively to the athletes while imparting training.

3. Age

Candidates should preferably be under 60 years of age. However, in exceptional cases, the constituent committee may consider older applicants based on their outstanding credentials and the specific requirements of the Olympic nodes.
