 Prospective supplier should provide 5% additional representative doses for each Stallion at the time of supply of doses, the cost of which has to be borne by the supplier. The same will be required for quality check at the port of entry as well as at the receiving stud.

3. <u>License Requirements for import of Equine Cryo-preserved Semen</u>

(a) In case, the import is being done through a private party, then the importer shall have to apply for 'import license' as per the details available in DGFT website. The importer has to process online only at DGFT website (https://dfgt.gov.in). The details of pre-requisites can be obtained from DGFT website.

- (b) For obtaining import license from DGFT, following requisites are required to be fulfilled:
 - Port of Registration. Proposed to be New Delhi.
 - (ii) CIF value of Equine Cryo-preserved Semen to be imported.
 - (iii) NOC from the Animal Husbandry Commissioner, Dept of Animal Husbandry & Dairying (Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry & Dairying), Government of India.
 - (iv) Details of Import-Export Code (IEC).
 - (v) Indian Trade Clarification Harmonized Code (ITCHS).
 - (vi) Quantity of Equine Cryo-preserved Semen to be imported.
 - (vii) Type of foreign currency to be utilized in procurement.
 - (viii) Country(s) of origin for importing of Equine Cryo-preserved Semen.
- 4. The requisites prior to the import of equine germplasm for the Department of Animal Husbandry & Dairying, (Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry & Dairying), Government of Indiawill be:
 - (a) NOC from Integrated Headquarters of Ministry of Defence (Army).
 - (b) Complete genetic and production data/information, including genetic marker report with respect to the equine germplasm proposed to be imported.
 - (c) Justifications for import of Equine Cryo-preserved Semen (will be provided by this Office).
 - (d) Future roadmap for utilization of imported germplasm (will be provided by this office).
- The imports are regulated as per the provision of Livestock Importation Act, 1898 and as per the protocols/Vet certificate for import is to be obtained from exporting organisation.

General information

- (a) The Equine Cryo-preserved Semen will be tentatively delivered at CIP, New Delhi.
- (b) Detailed technical specifications will be uploaded along with the RFP.
- (c) General health Protocol/quarantine requirements for seller's country and India will have to be strictly adhered. General guidelines can be obtained on the website https://aqcsindia.in. The cost of maintenance of doses of Equine Cryopreserved Semen during period of quarantine/testing will be borne by the seller.
- Quarantine requirement. Following quarantine requirements are required to be fulfilled after receipt of equine frozen semen at port of entry in India:-

- (a) Veterinary certificate for import of equine semen into India.
- (b) Certificatecum Declaration by the Official Vet regarding sanitary information of donor Horse Stallion to include information regarding semen of origin, its collection, disease testing, storage & transport etc.Disease free certificate for compulsorily notifiable diseases African Horse Sickness (AHS), Glanders, Equine Encephalomyelitis (EEE, WEE & VEE), Vesicular Stomatitis (VS), Equine Infectious Anaemia (EIA), Dourine, Rabies, Anthrax, Equine Trypanosomiasis (*T evansi*) of the Horse Stallions whose semen is intended to be imported is required to be furnished by host organisation.
- (c) Proficiency testing and quality assurance certificate from the exporting organisation will also be a mandatory requirement.
